Private landowners interested in preserving their farmland are encouraged to apply to the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation (MALPF) for the FY19 easement cycle.

**OFFER PRICE:** The application requires the landowner to submit an offer price that once submitted cannot be changed throughout the consideration of the application. When the State makes an offer it either makes an offer to the top farms on the County's ranking list or from a state wide list of farm owners whose asking price is at a greatest discount from the State determined easement value (Fair Market Value minus agricultural value). Please be aware that the funding for top farms is limited and all offers are capped at 75% of Fair Market Value as determined by state appraisals. Below are some gross numbers on easement prices. By March, we will have additional information from the last easement cycle available by request.
